## SECTION ONE: DECLARATION OF POLICY

It is hereby determined by the Town Board, that finding qualified assessors to run for elective office of Assessor and having said assessors complete the required training is difficult. In addition, the Town Assessments are subject to criticism when a full Board of Assessors does not exist or can not officially act because of certification. The State of New York, by Section 328 of the Real Property Tax Law has authorized Towns to establish the appointive office of sole Assessor.

## SECTION TWO: DEFINITIONS

The term "Assessor" shall have the meaning as defined in the Real Property Tax Law.

## SECTION THREE: ELECTION OF OPTION

The Town of New Lisbon, Otsego County, New York, pursuant to Real Property Tax Law Section 328 hereby enacts that there shall be but one Assessor for the Town of New Lisbon, to be appointed pursuant to the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York.

## SECTION FOUR: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall be effective June 1, 1994 at which time the terms of office of all elected Assessors in office shall terminate.
